







# BELGIAN PRESIDENCY, COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

Belgium holds the rotating presidency of the Council of the EU from 1 January to 30 June 2024. This Infotableau presents relevant data in relation to certain programmes of the presidency trio and the Belgian Presidency. #### THE ROTATING PRESIDENCY



The Presidency of the European Council rotates every six months between the Member States.



Member States work closely together in groups of three (trios): they set long-term goals and announce a joint programme.






